

“Partner Ministry” Agreement

SVM2 exists to network organizations in a widespread initiative to see more labourers from the emerging generation of believers (university and recent graduates) mobilized for the least reached. It networks ministries into a unified force within a given national context. As an informal vehicle, it promotes unity and focus around the pivotal themes of the emerging generation and the importance of spiritual awakening and cross-cultural mission vision being cultivated in their communities. In faith, SVM2 is seeking God to raise up 100,000 new labourers from across the emerging generation of believers for His harvest fields.

Statement of Purpose:

The SVM2 international network comes alongside Bible Schools, Campus Ministry Organizations, Local Churches and Mission Sending Agencies to catalyze the burgeoning/emerging student mission movement.

Because of the belief in what God is doing in building the cooperative student mission movement, Bible Schools, Campus Ministry Organizations, Local Churches and Mission Sending Agencies participate informally with the network as “Partner Ministries” toward this end.

Together, we seek to “serve our generation by the will of God (Acts 13:36)” through mobilizing the emerging generation of believers to wholehearted devotion to Christ which results in aligning their hearts with His global mission purpose among the unreached.

SVM2 Commits To:

1. Promote the Campus Ministry Organization on its website
2. Promote the mission conferences that the Campus Ministry Organization hosts.
3. If the Campus Ministry Organization is connected with a particular denomination or church network, SVM2 promotes the denominations’ cross-cultural mission opportunities on a national “GO List” of sending agencies. (see page 10 of Handbook).
4. Make available cutting edge equipping materials, resources and events to serve the student mission movement.
5. Make its leaders available to serve the Campus Ministry Organization through speaking engagements for conferences, special meetings, seminars, etc.

Campus Ministry Organization Commits To:

1. Link to www.SVM2.net from the ministry’s website (see the “Logos and Buttons” page on the SVM2 site with downloadable buttons)
2. Utilize proven cross-cultural mission mobilization tools (The Four Core Components) among its student fellowships. (see pages 7-8 of Handbook):
 1. Global Prayer Teams
 2. Bible Studies on God’s Heart for the Nations
 3. Student Mission Fellowships
 4. Calling Message Bearers (see p. 4 & 9 of Handbook)
3. Designate a “Facilitator” to help implement the tools within the Campus Ministry Organization (see pages 5-6 of Handbook).
4. Periodically promote events, prayer initiatives and resources to serve the student mission movement.
